## Sample Content is Below:

1<sup>st</sup> incident – time of the game [example –7:05 approximately in 1<sup>st</sup> quarter); and what occurred (blue team coach screamed at me because they felt I missed a check]

 $2^{nd}$  incident – time of game (example – 1:55 in the  $2^{nd}$  quarter), blue team coach complained bitterly that I missed an offensive charge

Halftime – my partner and I called both coaches over to remind them that if they have a question to call time out. Otherwise please refrain from commenting on the officiating. And that the next comment could warrant a card.

3<sup>rd</sup> incident – time of game – 11:20 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter; the blue coach continued to yell and question the calls of both my partner and me– at this time he felt that the white team swung wildly and missed his player.

At 11:20 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter – I issued the blue team coach a yellow card for misconduct.
